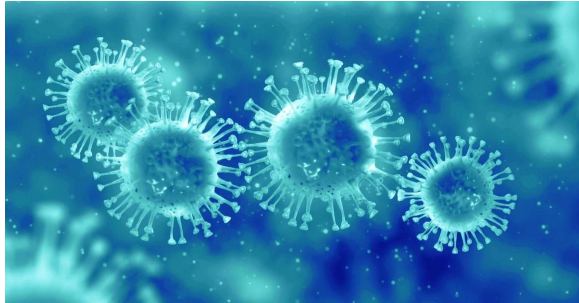


The Coronavirus
